## ◆ Regular Program

This program is for non-Koreans or ethnic Koreans living outside of Korea who hope to study Korean language thoroughly to move on to an undergraduate or a graduate level education in Korea. There are six levels in total and it takes about 1.5 years to complete from level 1 to 6.

### 2. Entrance Requirement

Anyone (both men and women) who is with a high school diploma or expected to graduate

### 3. Curriculum

- Levels: From 1 to 6
- Terms: 4 terms / year (Spring, Summer, Fall, Winter), 10 weeks / term
- Class Capacity: 10-15 students / class
- Class hours: 5 days per week (Mon ~ Fri), 4 hours per day, TOPIK class once a week
- Cultural Experience Class: Taekwondo, Samulnori, Korean cooking class, Cultural Performance etc. / once a term
- Special Events: Story-telling contest, field day, singing contest, sport games, Running man(Removing name tags) etc. / once a term

### 4. Special Program

- Korean Buddies  
SWU students who help you to study Korean and settle down in Korea
- Free Class  
- Kpop dance : 4 times / one term (Spring and Fall term only)  
- Korean speaking practice class : Practice speaking in Korean with SWU students

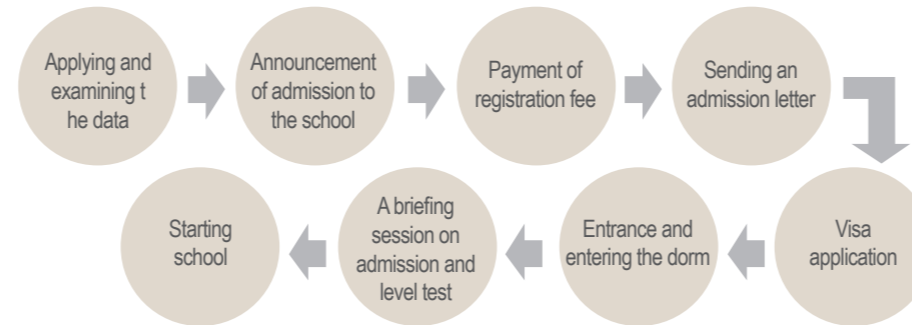
### 5. Scholarship

- First place prize: 200,000 won for the first class student in every term.
- Second place prize: 100,000 won for second class student in every term.
- Perfect attendance: Student whose attendance rate is 100% will be awarded a certificate and gift

### 6. Completion of a term

- Test 80%, Attitude 20%
- Students who scored an average 70 points or above in four classes (Speaking, Listening, Reading, Writing)
- With a minimum of 70 points in three out of the four subjects
- Students who have over 80% of attendance can complete a term.

### 1. Admission

- Application Form
- A photocopy of passport and 1 sheet of Photograph (White background)
- Official Academic Record of the latest institution enrolled (Diploma/Transcript/Certificate of Enrollment Etc.)
- Certificate of Academic Background (\*Relevant nationality only)
- Certificate of Bank Statement (for D-4 Visa holders only, over \$10,000)
- Letter of Personal Reference (\*Relevant nationality only)
- Chest X-ray report (for students who wish to stay in the dormitory only)  
The report(in English) can be three months before entry date of dormitory.

※ All documents submitted for application purposes will not be returned to applicants.

### \* Relevant nationalities (in accordance with the law of the Ministry of Justice)

Ghana, Nigeria, Nepal, Mongolia, Myanmar, Bangladesh, Vietnam, Sri Lanka, Uzbekistan, Ukraine, Iran, Egypt, India, Indonesia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Thailand, Pakistan, Peru, Philippines

### 2. Tuition Payment

- Application Fee 50,000 KRW (Non-refundable)
- Tuition: 1,400,000 KRW / term (Textbooks excluded)
- Wire payment with applicant's English name
- Cost difference (Over or Short) caused by exchange rate will be calculated after students' entry.

### 3. Insurance fee Payment

- Insurance Cost: 60,000 KRW
- Insurance Period: During the opening date of the term until the day before the next term.
- Subscription method: Account transfer with tuition fee
- If you have already signed up for other Korean insurance, please submit your insurance policy.
- The Others:  
The insurance policy should be valid until the last day of the term.  
The insurance issued in your home country is not accepted.
